Time Commitment

The Leadership Chatham class year begins with an Opening Reception & Orientation. The year ends with graduation in June of 2023. All educational sessions are daytime sessions that begin promptly between 8:00a - 8:30a and end between 4:00p - 5:00p. These full-day sessions are held one time a month, typically on the second Thursday of the month. Please reference the tentative schedule included in this brochure. Participants and a Chamber representative meet outside of scheduled sessions from time to time to discuss and work on their class project. Project meetings usually take place over lunch.

Acceptance into the Leadership Chatham Program

There is a maximum of 25 participants accepted for each class year of Leadership Chatham. Participants with diverse experience and involvement in the community are accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Graduation Requirements

Participants missing more than one (1) session are not eligible to graduate with their class. Missed sessions can be made up in the next class year at no additional cost to the participant. Participants are eligible to graduate once sessions are made up. ACTIVE participation in the group's class project is a requirement of graduation.
